



**Pelouche Turtleneck Sweater (C165)  
Using Cascade Bollicine Pelouche Pattern**



# Pelouche Turtleneck Sweater (C165)

**Materials:** Bollicine Pelouche 12  
Knitting needles size 11 and size 11 circular needle 16"

**Gauge:** 2 st = 1"

**Approximate finished size:** 33(39,41)

## **Back**

Cast on 42(52,62) sts. Work in k1, p1 rib for 1". Cont in Stockinette stitch until piece meas 18(18 ½, 19)" from beg. Bind off all stitches.

## **Front**

Work as for back, and at the same time: when piece meas 16(16 ½, 17)" work 16(21,26) sts, attach a 2<sup>nd</sup> ball of yarn, bind off 10 stitches, work to end. Work both sides at same time, bind off at each neck edge 2 sts twice, 1 st once. Work even until same length as back. Bind off loosely.

## **Sleeves**

Cast on 22(22,24) sts. Work in k1, p1 rib for 1", end with a WS row, Cont in stockinette stitch, inc 1 st each side on next row, then every 4<sup>th</sup> row 0(1,4) times, every 6 row 8(8,6) times. Work even until piece measures 17(17 ½, 17 ½)" or until desired length.

## **Neckband**

With RS facing, and circular needle pick up and knit 50 sts evenly around neck edge. Join and knit in k1, p1 rib for 8". Bind off in rib loosely. Sew side and sleeve seams.
