



# Small Triangle Purse

Using Cascade 220 Yarn



## SMALL TRIANGLE FELTED BAG

*Materials:* Cascade 220 2 skeins                      *Size:* 14" at the bottom X 9" tall  
                  Cascade Rio 5 skeins    *after felting*  
                  #10 ½ needles  
                  J crochet hook

*Use Cascade 220 Quartos for Tone on Tone effect*

*Cast on 3 stitches using #10 ½ needles and 1 strand of 220 and 1 strand of Rio together.*

*Work in Stockinette stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row). Increase 1 st at the beginning and the end of the needle every 4<sup>th</sup> row to 55 sts.*

*Work 2 rows without increasing, then decrease 1 st at the beginning and the end of the needle every 4<sup>th</sup> row to 3 sts. Bind off.*

*Fold the bag in half along the 55 sts row to form triangle.*

*Starting at the bottom edge and using your J crochet hook and 1 strand of Rio only, sc (single crochet) up the edge of the bag going through both layers. Be careful to leave an 8" opening at the top edge of purse. Sc up the other edge and around each top flap. Work another round of sc and remember to work 2 sc into the points of the flaps.*

*Handles can be crocheted or knitted as follows:*

*Crochet option=Using j hook and 1 strand of Rio and 2 strands of 220 Quatro, chain st for 30". (make 2) attach the handles at the top of each side seam.*

*Knit option= Cast on 5 sts on 10 ½ needle using 1 strand of Rio and 2 strands of 220 Quatro and knit every row for 30" and bind off. (make 2) Attach the handles to the top of the side seams.*

*Felting:*

*Put your bag in the washer using a mild or no-rinse soap, hot water and a low water lever. Agitate for 25 minutes or until stitches disappear. Finish the cycle, remove from washer, shape with your hands into the desired shape and allow to dry flat.*

*Adorn your bag with beads, buttons pins or anything else you can think of.*

*Enjoy your one of a kind bag!*
