KANGAROO SWEATER (W185)

size 2 (4,6)

Materials:

Cascade 220 SUPERWASH

100% superwash wool 220 yards 100 grams

2 skeins royal color - 813 "A"

1 skein yellow color - 821 "B"

1 skein green - color 864 "C"

1 skein orange - color 822 "D"

size 5 and 7 needles

size G/6 crochet hook

embroidery needle

1 royal 4-hole button - 3/8"

Gauge: 20 sts and 26 rows = 4"

Stripe pattern: *2 rows B, 2 rows D; repeat from* (4 rows)

Knitted measurements:

chest - 26 (28, 31)"

body length 14 (15 1/2, 17)"

sleeve length 11 1/2 (12, 12 1/2)"

armhole depth 5 3/4 (6 1/4, 6 3/4)"

Back:

With smaller needles and A cast on 64(70, 78)sts. Work in k1, p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to larger needles continue in St st until piece measures 14 (15 1/2, 17)" from beg. On WS bind off 19 (21, 25) sts for shoulder, work across 26 (28, 28) sts and place on holder, bind off remaining sts for shoulder.

Front:

Work as back until piece measures 2 3/4 (4 1/4, 5 3/4)" from beg. On RS and A, wk 21(24, 28)sts, join B and wk 22sts chart pattern #1, end 21 (24, 28)sts A. When complete, continue in A until piece measures 11 1/2 (13, 14 1/2)" from beg.

neck shaping: On RS K 27 (29, 33)sts, join second ball of yarn and bind off center 10 (12, 12) sts, wk to end. Wk both sides at once, bind off 3sts from each neck edge once, 2sts once, then decrease 1 st every other row twice. Wk even until piece measures 14 (15 1/2, 17)" from beg. Bind off remaining 19 (21, 25) sts for each shoulder.

Sleeves:

With smaller needles and D cast on 34 (36, 36) sts. Wk in k1, p1 rib for 8 rows. Change to larger needles and B, continue in St st and stripe pattern; increase 4 sts evenly across row #1 - 38 (40, 40) sts. AT SAME TIME: increase 1 st at each side every 6th row until 58 (62, 66)sts are reached. Wk even until piece measures 11 1/2 (12, 12 1/2)" from beg.

Finishing:

Block pieces to measurements. Sew left shoulder seam. neckband: With RS facing, with smaller needles and A, pick up and k 72 (74, 74)sts evenly around neck. Wk in k1, p1 rib for 7 rows. Bind off in

rib. Sew 2nd shoulder and neckband seam. Mark $5\frac{3}{4}$ ($6\frac{1}{4}$, $6\frac{1}{2}$)" down from shoulder at each armhole edge. Sew top of sleeve at armhole edge between markers. Sew remaining side and sleeve seams.

eye: With yellow thread attach eye as indicated on chart in "x" formation.

ears (2): With B and crochet hook, chain 12 sts, loop and sew center tog and attach as indicated on chart.

arms(2): With B and larger needles, cast on 6 sts. Wk in St st for 7 rows. Cut strand, thread through remaining sts close seam lengthwise and attach as indicated on chart, leaving hand end loose.

pocket: With C and larger needles, cast on 11sts. Working in St st, increase 1 st each end every other row until 19 sts are reached. Wk even until piece measures $1\frac{3}{4}$ " from beg. Wk in k1 p1 rib for 3 rows. bind off in rib. With strand of C, attach with wip stitch as indicated on chart (allow for slight fullness)
